DEFINITION

Cadets perform routine non-sworn duties under direct supervision. Tasks are completed on a rotational basis throughout bureaus of the Police Department in preparation for a law enforcement career. Cadets will be mentored by Police Officer Mentors while advising Athens-Clarke County Police Explorers. Additionally, Cadets will accumulate hands-on training and experiences in the classroom and field.

JOB RELATED REQUIREMENTS

Work Schedule: Scheduling is based on the Cadets' class schedule and availability



*Cadets Must
Be Willing . . .*

- . . . to serve and fully participate in Cadet activities & duties*
- . . . to accept and follow all procedures and regulations of the Agency and Program*
- . . . to participate in a physical fitness test*
- . . . and available to participate in Cadet Academy*
- . . . to work at least 8 hours and no more than 10 hours per week*
- . . . and flexible to work weekdays and weekends*
- . . . to participate in Ride Alongs*

MINIMUM REQUIREMENTS FOR APPLICATION

Full-Time Student in High School or College

Must be at least 16 years old

College Students: Have at least a "C" (2.75) GPA on the most recent transcript

High School Students: A 2.0 GPA is preferred

Have NO criminal record of serious arrests or convictions (felony or high-aggravated misdemeanor)

Have NO current affiliation with a gang or any other criminal group

Be free of any physical or psychological condition that limits full participation in the Cadet Program, or that could jeopardize the safety of the applicant or anyone in the Program

Have written permission (Parental Waiver Form) from a parent or legal guardian allowing them to join the Cadet Program under 18 years old
